Students who complete the following courses successfully at BryanLGH College of Health Sciences will receive a minor in these fields that will be recorded on their official transcripts. Students interested in attaining one or more of these minors need to complete the appropriate form in the Office of Records and Registration. Minor in Biomedical Sciences

Students complete 15 hours in any of the following courses (all taken at BCHS). Credits earned in these classes may be applied to an advanced degree in a biomedical field such as nurse practitioner or nurse anesthetist.
