

Dear Volunteer Parent/Guardian:

According to the policy of BryanLGH Medical Center, volunteers must show immunity to measles (rubeola), mumps, rubella and chicken pox (varicella), before beginning their volunteer service. Please provide the immunization information as indicated on the History of Immunizations form.

If immunization records are not available, this individual may be asked to have a blood test to check for immunity to measles (rubeola), mumps, rubella and/or chicken pox (varicella). If found not to be immune, a vaccination will be required.

In addition, all volunteers must have a tuberculin skin test before starting their volunteer service.

Parental/Guardian consent is needed for any individual under 19 years or over 19 years if under legal guardianship.
